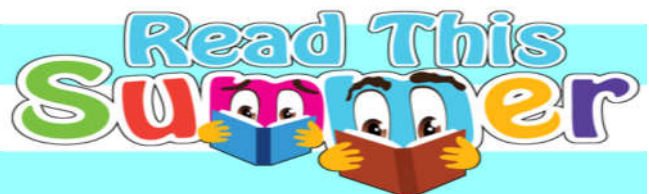

Children's Services Announcements

Online registration is required for Children's Programs/Activities unless otherwise specified. A valid Plainedge Public Library card, with an established PIN, is required for each individual registrant. To create a PIN for each Library card holder: Go to our homepage www.plainedgelibrary.org. To register: Go to our Library's home page and click on the *Kids Programs* logo under *Popular*.

If you do not provide the information, we will not be able to contact you in a timely manner of cancellations or changes. *Registrations are not complete without this information and we reserve the right to give spots to other children on the waiting list.* All programs are age specific, including those where adults attend with children.
