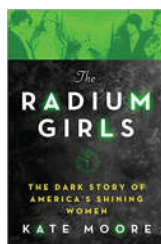

NEW MUSEUM PASSES ARE HERE

COE HALL AND THE PLANTING FIELDS - <https://plantingfields.org>

Planting Fields is the former estate of William and Mai Coe and is one of the few remaining estates located on the North Shore of Long Island. There are 409 acres of historic buildings that still contain many of the original pieces and furnishings and beautiful landscapes, hiking trails and formal gardens. The pass allows 2 adults and 4 children.

THE COLD SPRING HARBOR FIRE MUSEUM - www.cshfirehousemuseum.org

Step into the past and visit this Nationally Registered Fire House (circa 1896). Go back to a time when neighbors stood side by side in the small whaling port of Cold Spring Harbor and fought the fires. This pass allows 2 adults and 4 children.

HARBES BARNYARD ADVENTURE PARK FUN - www.harbesfamilyfarm.com

Harbes Barnyard Adventure is the paid admission area of Harbes Family Farm in Mattituck. There are 8 acres (the same as 6 football fields put together!) for visitors to explore. At this family-friendly attraction, you'll discover hands-on learning experiences including farm animals and chicken and bee observatories. There are also fun and games for all ages such as our Gnome Hedge Maze, trike track, Jumbo Jumpers, sports zone, and so much more. Weekends, holidays, and summer Fridays they offer pig races, singing hayride tours and hosted interactive activities with Farmer Fred. This pass admits up to 4 people per day

NEW YORK STATE EMPIRE PASS - <https://parks.ny.gov>

The Empire Pass is your key to all-season enjoyment at New York State Parks.

Valid for the pass holder and their occupants in **one** vehicle at the time of entry. Day-use entry only.

I used a lightbulb image to represent ideas and it's filled with colors to represent many different ideas, thoughts, expertise and information... exactly what the library of today has become and now represents."

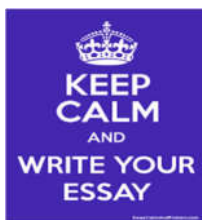

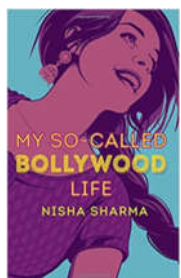
Hiding by Henry Turner

If you do not provide the information, we will not be able to contact you in a timely manner of cancellations or changes. *Any online registration without a phone number and email address is now considered incomplete.
